It gives me great pleasure to invite you to participate in Proje 4L- Istanbul Contemporary Art Museum's inaugural exhibition.

The title is yet to be determined, but the exhibition will pivot around the issues of public and private spaces as it applies to Istanbul;

The artists in the exhibition are Eric Grongrich, (on a fellowship from the Berlin Senate), Hüseyin Alptekin, Gülsün Karamustafa, Aydan Murtezaoglu, Bülent Sangar and Halil Altindere. There will also be a number of video based works one of which includes a conversation by Hans Ulrich Obrist.

The exhibition will open to the public on September 21, a day before the 7th Istanbul Biennial. The exhibition also presents a great opportunity for the institution and the artist as it will also incorporate the Biennial's public. There will be a catalogue and related programming.
