Thanks for your mail.

First of all we really appreciate to learn that the exhibition is still well visited – we had expected that the last 2–3 weeks of the exhibition period would be somewhat quiet!

We have briefly discussed the possibility of taking the exhibition to Ankara or even Bodrum but it was shelved as we were concerned not to be able to get necessary funding. However, as the idea is not completely abandoned we should appreciate if you could accept that we pick-up the panels and keep them in our storage – in case we later on decides to make use of them we shall be ready to negotiate a fee to be paid to you in the range of USD 1.000,-. If you can accept this proposal we shall arrange to have the panels picked up early next week. Do you have solid transportation and storage boxes for the panels?
