Many of these artists have studied in Western Europe, notable in France and Italy, and many have participated in such major international exhibitions as the Venice and Sao Paolo Biennials. Others have works represented in important private and public collections, including in the Museum of Modern Art and the Guggenheim in New York. Some of the works in the exhibition will be for sale.
