INKIJK and SKOR

Fulya wants a SKOR-related programme for the INKIJK.

Olga can continue her work but will be coached by Nils or Theo to benefit the curator expertise of the two. NvB: up till now INKIJK was a side thing with no budget or time available.

TT: it could be more imbedded in SKOR's policy with exhibitions, projects, publications etc.

FE: INKIJK is the shop-window of SKOR, the garden too could be involved; invitations to artists for garden projects once a year. Subject of Olga's programme, "identity", is not current or urgent today, also the Amsterdam connection must be made. It would be good if SKOR opens up more and will be easier accessible to others. It must become an Art and Public institution.

Ideas come up, like a specialised bookshop on public space art in the INKIJK(TT), more earlier communication about projects like the kick off of the WP (OCG), SKOR web site is a public space as well (NvB), a blog makes it possible to give insights in the process of projects. Theoretical articles can be added, discussions started, updates and news of projects can be updated after each team meeting. Good example for the web site is the magazine Zehar Olga suggests
